As part of your child's GCSE course, there is a significant benefit to completing fieldwork in preparation for their examination. The Geography Department is therefore running a visit to the Holderness Coast, Bridlington, to complete the fieldwork on **Friday 11 July 2025**.

This visit will give students valuable experience developing fieldwork skills and completing compulsory data collection for their research project required for the GCSE Paper 3 Examination.

We will be travelling by coach and focusing our visit on the centre of Bridlington, as well as to the North and South Beaches. Students will need to wear suitable clothing and footwear for outdoor fieldwork and a packed lunch or money for their own lunch.
