We are excited to let you know that we are taking part in the Brake Kids Walk.

This is a great way for us to talk about road safety and raise funds to help the Brake Charity campaign for safe and healthy journeys, and support families affected by road accidents. The main aim of Brake's Kids Walk is to promote the health and planet-saving benefits of walking. It's also a great way to raise awareness among parents and the local community about protecting children on our roads.

On average, more than six children are killed or seriously injured on roads in Britain every day – that's equivalent to a whole class of children every single week. We are doing our bit to try and make sure this never happens in our community. You can help us by supervising your child closely on roads and continuing to teach road safety as you do.

We are also encouraging children to become ambassadors for road safety. We want them to speak up for their right to make safe and healthy journeys and one way they can do this is to ask grown-ups to help keep them safe near roads.

The whole school will take part in this activity; we will be walking the children down Winthorpe Road, along Boothferry Road, then down Penshurst Avenue and back into the school. The walk will take place during the morning of **Tuesday 10 June 2025**.
